shoes, abnormalities in walking patterns, obesity, and having flat feet.

There are other remedies such as soaking the feet in the water. This can help soften calluses and make them

easy to eliminate. It can also be useful to use moisturizer to keep the feet soft.

Individuals with calluses are advised to avoid using very sharp objects such as a razor blade or knife. These

tools can place them at a high risk of injury and infection. It is also important to note that calluses could be a

symptom of an underlying condition such as diabetes.

According to the CNN health website, it can be helpful for women to avoid wearing high heels. Calluses can
