Each of their teachers have been carefully chosen to ensure that the developmental needs of the children are achieved and that their curiosities are allowed to run free. The preschool allows the children to search for those experiences that they feel are new, intriguing and imaginative. In this way, the children are able to discover their goals, interests, and talents.

Another factor that has earned the trust of parents in Villa Montessori Preschool Leesburg are the Montessori classrooms, which have been beautifully designed to help build self-confidence in the children, to promote hands-on learning experiences, and inspire curiosity. The comfortable and attractive learning environments provided for the students allow them to play and learn at their preferred pace, guided by their specific interests.

Villa Montessori Preschool Leesburg has pointed out that the Montessori classrooms are considered to be "the third teacher" for the children. The classrooms have been designed such that materials and projects are within easy reach of the children so that they can explore independently. Every part of the classrooms has been designed such that when the students interact with that part, their interests are developed and they get to make new discoveries.

Meanwhile, the Reggio-inspired playground at Villa Montessori Preschool Leesburg has been designed to encourage creative play. The open areas are large enough to allow the children to run and climb and the huge play structures encourage them to use their imagination. Outdoor blackboards are also provided so that the children can express their creativity and artistry.

As can be gleaned by its name, the Villa Montessori Preschool Leesburg makes use of the

Montessori Method, which revolutionized early childhood education. It was developed by Dr. Maria Montessori because she observed that it is natural for children to want to learn and explore their environments. She, therefore, developed the Montessori curriculum where the educational materials have been scientifically designed to be project oriented and to allow hands-on learning.

In addition to the Montessori Method, the Villa Montessori Preschool Leesburg has also integrated the Reggio approach to early childhood education. This comes from the Reggio Emilia philosophy that was developed by Loris Malaguzzi and quite similar to the Montessori Method. The Reggio method is designed to help children develop higher critical thinking skills that are required in order for them to understand what questions to ask. This departs from the traditional approach where students are required to memorize information. The rote memory approach is no longer beneficial because it is now easy to search for information because of technology. What students need to learn are what questions to ask to enhance their knowledge.

At the Villa Montessori Preschool Leesburg, the programs are tailored to the age of the child. There is the Toddler class is for children who are 18 months to 24 months old. The Pre-Primary Class is for children who are 24 months to 36 months old. The Primary Class is a mixed age group of children with ages 3 to 6 years. The Kindergarten Class are for children who turn five not later than September 30. Here, language, math, science, art, history, geography, and cultural studies are combined, and a low student/teacher ratio is maintained to ensure very personalized teaching.
