Dr. Sorr explains that for those who join one of the Source Of Health membership plans, they would be supported in their pursuit of health on an on-going basis. He says, "We are committed to achieving a higher standard of care by providing safe and effective treatments utilizing functional and regenerative medicine so that our community can forgo the reliance on drugs or surgery and live to experience abundant health and wellness."

Source Of Health offers both "look better" and "feel better" procedures. Their procedures for making people look better include Exilis Ultra and Z-Wave, PRP facial rejuvenation, hair loss restoration, botox and dermal fillers, and laser treatments. Their procedures for making people feel better include stem cell therapy, PRP injections, dextrose prolotherapy, hormone replacement therapy, advanced diagnostics labs, drip lounge, and nutrition and lifestyle counseling.

Their "feel better" procedures are based on regenerative medicine, which makes use of the power of the body to heal unstable and damaged joints and ligamentous laxity, without resorting to painkiller and anti-inflammatory drugs. In stem cell therapy, the patient's own stem cells are used to stimulate the healing of damaged ligaments, cartilage, meniscus, and tendons. This may be combined with platelet-rich plasma (PRP) therapy to boost the healing process. PRP injections are composed of concentrated growth factors found in the patient's own blood platelets, and these are used for healing soft tissue injuries. Dextrose prolotherapy is also a natural injection solution that stimulates the patient's own body to heal damaged cartilage, tendons, and ligaments.

Meanwhile, hormone replacement therapy is used to correct an imbalance in the patient's hormone levels. Aging and stress can cause hormone levels to increase or decrease and this can result in symptoms like fatigues, low mood, depression, frequent colds, and decreased libido. Source Of Health will look at the specific needs of individual patients, based on blood work and feedback, and develop a customized prescription that will balance estrogen, progesterone, testosterone, HGH, DHEA, and other body systems.

Furthermore, Source Of Health offers nutritional IV therapy. This has the advantage of bypassing the gut so that 100 percent of the nutrients can reach the tissues where they are needed the most. Thus,

vitamin C can be given in much higher doses than is possible through oral therapy. Some of the benefits of nutritional IVs are: recovery from or preparation for a sports event; enhanced healing ability and collagen formation; rehydration; boosting of energy; cold and flu prevention, treatment or recovery; detoxification; mood balancing; and treatment for poor intestinal absorption that is often experienced by patients with celiac disease, Crohn's disease, irritable bowel syndrome, and more.
