

Justin Timberlake's Drummer Interviewed By AIMM

The Atlanta Institute of Music in Duluth, Georgia has announced that they recently held a [Brian Frasier-Moore interview](#), drummer for Justin Timberlake. Frasier-Moore has a number of stars in his portfolio, including Madonna, Janet Jackson, Christina Aguilera and many more.

Brian Frasier-Moore was born in Philadelphia and has been a drummer for more than 25 years. Nite Driscoll, a representative for AIMM says, "It was truly an honor to interview Brian. We hope that his story will help to motivate drummers all over the world."

He continues to add that the school believes that educated musicians make the biggest impact in the industry. Their Drum Program includes courses that cover music theory as well as music performance, two things that Driscoll state are crucial for anyone who wants to enjoy a successful career in the industry.

Steve Freeman founded the [Atlanta Institute of Music and Media](#) in 1985. The school's mission statement was revised in 1993 by the governing board in order to better define the instruction that is offered through their various courses. Current President, Nite Driscoll, revised the mission statement further in 1997 to offer a clearer explanation of the overall purpose of the school and the courses that they offer. Driscoll says that today, AIMM has a goal of instructing and helping to develop the talent and knowledge of each student in order to prepare them for a successful music career in a number of capacities. The school expanded its course offerings in 2008 to include a recording arts program of

study, as well.

AIMM provides non-beginning students with instrument instruction and courses that are necessary to develop their talents and skills to reach higher levels of success. Driscoll says that they regularly interview musical talents in the industry to help students to realize that musical talent comes from all walks of life. Their interview with Frasier-Moore outlines his career and his successes, giving students motivation to reach their own levels of success. Driscoll says that they highly recommend that any student who is considering a musical career, particularly those who are considering drumming careers, watch the video or read through the interview transcript to better understand the personal side of a professional music career.
