The interlayer materials can be combined in any way imaginable, then given a background color. Clients can then put a textured or a patterned glass design within each glass wall panel to complete the process (examples of previously made designs can be found at www.Livingglass.com). Their architectural decorative glass can be used for a myriad of projects including decorative glass panels, room dividers and office partitions, doors, tables and furniture, safety railings, lighting, barbacks and backsplashes, non-slip flooring on stairs and bathrooms, and on ceilings and countertops. Their special brand of architectural glass can do it all.
