

# Bedford College Launches New Website For Child Care Courses In Sydney

For Gillespie, everything the college offers is about the future. He said, "It is fitting that the new metro link was recently completed, giving access to our Norwest Campus, with a station immediately opposite the college. This will open us up for people from all over Sydney, and we hope this will be reflected in more students coming to Bedford College."

He went on to say that, "In Australia, it is now common for both parents to work, so the need for high quality child care is growing. We at Bedford College provide that in an upbeat environment, and our newly launched website is a sign that we embrace new technologies and are looking to the future. "

The website showcases multiple videos of their child care students in action as well as news updates on current events around both the Bedford College campuses. It is designed to put new students first. Its intuitive nature allows it to give applicants a smooth experience evaluating what is on offer so they may decide what is suitable for them and then choose the right course for them to enroll in.

Students who wish to investigate alternative methods of funding their course will be pleased to learn there is a clear section of the site designed to help them evaluate the financial options at their disposal. Course lengths range from 20-52 weeks in 2020, and Bedford students undertake almost twice the practicum hours of students from other training organisations during these courses. This means that they have plenty of practical experience to back up the theoretical knowledge and skills that they gain at Bedford College.

Another section of the site features testimonials from previous students, highlighting the benefits they gained from attending a course at Bedford College.
