

Prairie Trails Subdivision In The Village Of Manhattan Gets New Website

Prairie Trails is a single-family home community in the [Village of Manhattan](#), IL. They have launched a website for relaying information to current and future homeowners. The community is located in the Lincoln-Way high school district. It has ranch and 2 story homes in many different styles starting from \$280K. The community has walking trails that wind around beautiful ponds and countryside setting. The community has a 20 acre lake. It is next to the Wauponsee glacial trail which is a 22 mile hiking and biking trail. Prairie Western Trails was originally known as Benck's farm.

The website provides details about upcoming meetings and events. The website has a calendar of neighborhood events and news. There is an option to export the calendar in a universal format that can be imported to the homeowner's preferred software. There is even a listing section to connect home buyers and sellers. The website also has pictures that showcase the natural beauty from the 46.66 total acres that the community covers.

The website also has links to pay the bills(a feature which is still under development but is coming soon), report issues, and read the minutes of board meetings. The website also has pictures of the secretary, treasurer and president of the board. The website has links to a FAQ section that answers the question regarding the law governing the homeowner's association. Homeowners can log into the website and access extra functionality. There is an email contact button on the website for those who wish to get more info through direct communication.

Manhattan had a population of just over 7000 people according to the 2010 census, which is estimated to have risen to around 8000 in 2019. It was incorporated in 1886 making it an old and established community. It was mostly settled by Irish immigrants who moved there due to the railroad construction work. The village was eventually incorporated to obtain a saloon license. The early spring festival Irish Fest gives the people living there an expression of their German and Irish heritage.

Manhattan lies in School District 114 which is one of the higher-achieving districts in Illinois. It is served by 3 grade schools while high school aged teens attend Lincoln-Way high school in New Lenox, IL. The village is served by American Legion Post number 935 and the Lions Club. They are also served by the Boy Scouts of America, Rainbow Council, Troop 155, and Cub Scouts Pack 155. Manhattan is the southern terminus station on Metra's SouthWest Service which provides daily rail service to Union Station in Chicago, Illinois. In the private sector, Manhattan is also the home base for

Starcon Inc, a major petrochemical contractor and Boing! Motorsports, an engine and chassis company.

Jack added, "Given the rich history and the economic significance of the area, we wanted to make sure we incorporated all the possible information and features on the website. The point was to really showcase the community and attract new visitors and future homeowners. I think we have done a terrific job with it. It should serve the community of Prairie Trails for years to come. It should also help convince those who are considering the community as an option for home ownership.
