The company states that dryer vents often get damaged due to the build up of lint inside them. In addition to taking longer to dry clothes, owners should keep an eye on whether the clothes feel very hot at the end of the drying cycle, a burnt or stale odor lingers around the appliance or the laundry room feels very humid. In fact, dryers are the number one reason for household fires, as the venting and the lint trap are the two most common places where a fire could start. Across the US, over 2,900 home clothes dryer fires are reported each year, causing \$35 million in property loss as well as many injuries. According to FEMA, some recorded cases even end in death. The number one reason for these fires is failure to clean the dryer.
