Ho Chi Minh (often referred to as Saigon) is a historic and bustling city in the southern part of Vietnam with a population of approximately 8.9 million. The city is home to a number of old western-style buildings that have now turned into tourist attractions. This includes the famous Notre-Dame Cathedral, which was made entirely of materials imported from France, and the 19th-century Central Post Office. The Notre-Dame Cathedral Basilica of Saigon, officially known as Cathedral Basilica of Our Lady of The Immaculate Conception, is located in Ho Chi Minh's downtown area. The church was built during the 1800s and is regarded as one of the finest gems of French architecture. Its interior space showcases 12 gigantic pillars that are perfectly lined up within the two sides of the hall while its exterior facade was built from Marseille-originated red bricks with a stunning clock that was brought from Switzerland in 1887.
