Sewer Backup: A sewer system backup is probably the most urgent emergency situation. This is especially true if sewage is backing up into the home. These problems need immediate attention to prevent further damage and health issues.

Clogged Drains: If the sink, bathtub, or shower is draining slowly, it may not warrant an emergency call. However, if it's completely plugged up, it can't be used for normal activities, like washing dishes, brushing teeth or bathing.

Leaking Water Heater: A small leak in the water heater may only require a new valve. But if the water heater has completely rusted through, it needs to be replaced quickly.

Broken Water Lines: Water lines leading to the home from the outside can be damaged by several causes. Tree roots, improper digging, and even earthquakes can cause underground water lines to break.

Burst Pipes: If exposed pipes are not properly insulated, they can freeze and burst. A burst pipe can release 100 gallons of water within an 8 hour period. Water damage restoration is an expensive undertaking, and mold may begin to grow quickly.

Clogged Toilets: The toilet is probably the most used fixture in a home. If it won't flush, is leaking, or overflows, immediate attention is needed.

Leaky Faucets and Toilets: The constant drip, drip, drip is enough to annoy anyone, but leaky faucets and toilets can also rack up water bills, cause rust to form and facilitate mold growth.

Sump Pump Failure: When the sump pump malfunctions, it can cause severe flooding inside the home. A professional plumber should be contacted immediately to remedy the situation.
